ORDINANCE No. 19 of 1953.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pounds Ordinance, Chapter 93, with respect to the impounding of strays and for matters connected therewith.

[16th May, 1953.]

A.D. 1953 — BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance shall be cited as the Pounds (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, and shall be construed with the Pounds Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Cap. 93.

Amendment of section 24 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution for the words "general rules and regulations," in subsection (1) of the word "regulations,";
- (b) by the substitution for the words "for reducing" in subsection (1) of the words "for increasing, reducing, varying or in respect of any area for such period as the Governor in Council shall think fit for suspending, the payment or collection of";
- (c) by the deletion of the words "rules and" in subsection (2).

Revocation of previous rules and regulations. 3. The Pound Fees Rules and Regulations, 1937, (published in the *Gazette* on the 15th day of January, 1938, at page 112) are hereby revoked.
