ORDINANCE No. 21 OF 1953

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Local Government Ordinance, 1945 by continuing in force for a further year the register of voters for the village of Bartica, in the County of Essequibo for the year ending the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government (Bartica Voters Register Continuance) Ordinance, 1953, and shall be construed with the Local Government Ordinance, 1945, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (4) of section forty-seven of the Principal Ordinance, the register of voters for the village of Bartica, in the County of Essequibo, for the year ending the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-two shall be deemed to have continued in force and shall continue in force for a further period of twelve months commencing from the first of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, and any act or thing performed or done in pursuance of sections thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty, forty-one, forty-two and forty-three of the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid.
