ORDINANCE No 23 OF 1953.

A.D. 1953. AN ORDINANCE to allow and confirm certain additional expenditure and to appropriate certain supplies incurred or granted during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

[31st December, 1953]

WHEREAS expenditure was necessarily incurred during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three on certain of the services mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance but not provided for by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1953;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to appropriate from revenue for expenditure on certain other services mentioned in the Schedule to this Ordinance a sum over and above the sum appropriated by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1953;

AND WHEREAS the expenditure incurred and the sum required to be appropriated as aforesaid amount to a sum of six million six hundred and sixty-three thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine dollars and eighty-five cents;

AND WHEREAS of this additional amount expended or required as aforesaid for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three the sum of twenty-four thousand eight hundred dollars has been provided by law and it is now requisite to make provision confirming the expenditure of and appropriating from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony a total sum of six million six hundred and thirty-nine thousand and ninety-nine dollars and eighty-five cents;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana in accordance with the provisions of Part III of the British Guiana (Constitution) (Temporary Provisions) Order in Council, 1953.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance, 1953. Short Title.

2. The expenditure incurred during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, on certain of the services as set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance and not provided for or not fully provided for by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1953, is hereby allowed and confirmed. Supplementary amount authorised for financial year 1953.

3. The Treasurer shall on the warrant of the Governor pay from the annual revenue for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-three and other resources of the Colony a sum, not exceeding in the aggregate the difference between the sum of six million six hundred and thirty-nine thousand and ninety-nine dollars and eighty-five cents as set forth in the Schedule hereto and the sum of the expenditure confirmed by section two of this Ordinance, for the purpose of defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony and for other purposes during the said year. Treasurer to defray expenses of Civil Government.
