ORDINANCE No. 1 of 1954.

An Ordinance to continue in force the Rent Restriction Ordinance. 1941.

including the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-three, shall continue in force and shall be deemed always to have continued in force as though the Principal Ordinance as amended had been continued in force by resolution of the Legislative Council in accordance with the provisions of section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance for the period commencing on the 1st day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, and ending on No. 23 of the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-four.
