ORDINANCE No. 2 of 1954.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the Supplies granted in the Current Session of the Legislative Council.

[13th March, 1954].

WHEREAS of the amount of Thirty-three million eight hundred and fifteen thousand six hundred and eighty-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, the sum of two million seven hundred and nineteen thousand two hundred and ninety-five dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of thirty-one million and ninety-six thousand three hundred and ninety-two dollars:

 title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1954.

2. The Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate thirty-one million and ninety-six thousand three hundred and ninety-two dollars as set forth in the Schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the said year.
