ORDINANCE No. 9 OF 1954.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Constabulary Ordinance to provide for the extension of the date on which certain non-commissioned officers and constables may exercise the option with regard to pensions

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Constabulary Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 85C of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by section 2 of the Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and as amended by section 2 of the Constabulary (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, the Governor in Council may extend the time within which any non-commissioned officer or constable may exercise the option under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance.
