ORDINANCE No. 16 OF 1954.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance to vary the procedure relating to the publication of draft rules of court.

[19th June, 1954.]

ENACTED by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1954

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Supreme Court of Judicature Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 10.

2. Section seventy-seven of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section three of the Supreme Court Ordinance, 1930, hereby further amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (a) and the substitution therefor of the following—

Amendment of section 77 of the Principal Ordinance. No. 25 of 1930

“(a) at least fourteen days before making any rules of court, notice of the proposal to make them shall be published in the Gazette and such notice shall specify the places at which copies of the draft rules are available for inspection;”.
