ORDINANCE No. 18 OF 1954.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance with respect to the borrowing powers of the Council.

[10th July, 1954].

ENACTED by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Cap. 86.

2. Section two hundred and twelve of the Principal Ordinance, as enacted by section three of the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, 1936, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one hundred thousand" in subsections (1) and (2) thereof of the words "two hundred thousand".
