ORDINANCE No. 20 OF 1954.

AN ORDINANCE to confer on the Commissioner of Local Government certain functions in respect of convicts' licences and the removal of prisoners presently exercisable by the Chief Secretary.

Section two of the Prison Ordinance, 1929, as amended by the Governor in Council on the eleventh day of April, 1953 under the provisions of the Official Designations Ordinance, 1938, and amended by the Prison (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, is hereby further amended by the substitution for the words "Chief Secretary" of the words "Commissioner of Local Government".
