ORDINANCE No. 37 OF 1954

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Rent Restriction (Continuance) Ordinance, 1954.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rent Restriction (Continuance) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Rent Restriction (Continuance) Ordinance, 1954, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of section two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end thereof, and by the addition of the following proviso—

“Provided that no person shall be liable to be prosecuted, convicted or punished under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance for anything done or omitted between the first day of January, 1954, and the fifteenth day of January, 1954, inclusive.”
