ORDINANCE No. 39 OF 1954

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Factories Ordinance, 1947.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Factories (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be construed and read as one with the Factories Ordinance, 1947, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The definition of the expression "factory" in section two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition to paragraph (a) of the following proviso—

"Provided that no place situate within the close, curtilage, or precincts forming a factory and solely used for some purpose other than the processes carried on in the factory, shall be deemed to form part of a factory, but such place shall, if otherwise it would be a factory, be deemed to be a separate factory."

3. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section three of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

4. Subsection (3) of section thirty-three of the Principal Ordinance as substituted by section nine of the Factories (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, is hereby amended—

- (a) by relettering paragraphs (i), (j) and (k) as paragraphs (j), (k) and (l) respectively;
- (b) by the insertion after paragraph (h) of the following new paragraph—

"(i) being the employer of a person employed in a factory, or in any occupation in a factory contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of subsection (4) of section twenty-nine; or"

5. Subsection (1) of section forty-two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the commas and words "in cases under subsection (2) of section three of this Ordinance, by an inspector and in all other cases".
