## BRITISH GUIANA

### ORDINANCE No. 1 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the British Guiana Rice Producers Association (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1953, with respect to the terms of office of Members of Committees of District Associations and of the Council of the British Guiana Rice Producers Association, and for purposes connected therewith.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the British Guiana Rice Producers Association (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the British Guiana Rice Producers Association (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1953, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
