## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 4 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Public Health Ordinance, 1934.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1955

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Public Health Ordinance, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended—

(a) by the repeal of subsection (10) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection —

“(10) The validity of any proceeding of the Board shall not be affected by any vacancy amongst the members thereof, or by any defect in the appointment of a member thereof.”;

(b) by the insertion after subsection (10) of the following new subsections —

“(11) The Governor may grant leave of absence to any member of the Board.

(12) Where leave has been granted to a member of the Board, the Governor may, subject to the provisions of subsection (2) of this section, appoint another person to act in the place of the member of the Board who has been granted such leave.”
