BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 6 OF 1955

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislative Council.

WHEREAS of the amount of thirty-seven million four hundred and thirty-seven thousand, seven hundred and eighty-two dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, the sum of two million, nine hundred and thirty thousand, and four hundred and six dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of thirtyfour million, five hundred and seven thousand, three hundred and seventy-six dollars:
