BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 10 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Teachers Pensions Ordinance with respect to the rate of pension.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1955

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955 and shall be construed and read as one with the Teachers Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section three A of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by section three of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1938, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "a gratuity equal to ten times the amount" of the words "a gratuity equal to twelve and one half times the amount".

Subsection (4) of section three B of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by section two of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "a gratuity equal to ten times the amount" of the words "a gratuity equal to twelve and one half times the amount".
