## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No 15 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Mining (Consolidation) Ordinance with respect to the payment of royalty on timber cut on concessions and leases granted under that Ordinance.

ENACTED by the Legislature of British Guiana:--

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining (Consolidation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mining (Consolidation) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Repeal and re-enactment of section 21 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor—

“Payment of royalty on timber in certain circumstances.

21. (1) The holder of any concession or lease granted under this Ordinance may, within such concession or lease, cut and use without the payment of royalty, any timber growing thereon.

(2) The holder of any concession or lease granted under this Ordinance shall not remove from any such concession or lease any timber cut thereon except on the payment of royalty at the rates prescribed by Regulations made under this Ordinance.”
