BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 17 OF 1955

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, with respect to the payment of a gratuity where an officer or servant dies in the service of the Georgetown Town Council.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
