ORDINANCE No. 18 OF 1955

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Criminal Law (Offences) Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :--

A.D. 1955.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Law Short title. (Offences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Criminal Law (Offences) Cap. 17. Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section seventy-five of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment of amended section 75
