## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 18 OF 1955

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Criminal Law (Offences) Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1955.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Law (Offences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Criminal Law (Offences) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 17.

Amendment of section 75 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section seventy-five of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the deletion of the words and commas “, not being a common prostitute or of known immoral character,” in paragraph (a);
- (b) by the deletion of the words, brackets and comma “(that place not being a brothel),” in paragraph (d).

Amendment of section 76 of the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section seventy-six of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words and commas “, not being a common prostitute or of known immoral character,”.
