## BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 26 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

(a) by the substitution for the words “seven thousand two hundred dollars” in sub-section (1) of the words “ten thousand and eighty dollars”; and

(b) by the substitution for the words "three thousand six hundred dollars" in sub-section (2) of the words "five thousand and forty dollars".

3. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one thousand nine hundred and twenty dollars" of the words "three thousand dollars".
