## BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 27 OF 1955.

An Ordinance further to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended — ment or section 8

(a) by the substitution for item (28) of the following — "(28) Passport —

(a) on first issue ... 3.00 (b) on renewal ... 1.50";

(b) by the substitution for item (30) of the following — "(30) Collective Travel

Certificate ... 3.00";

(c) by the insertion after item (30) of the following — "(30A) Travel Permit ... 0.50".
