# BRITISH GUIANA

## ORDINANCE No. 41 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Holidays with Pay Ordinance, 1952.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Holidays with Pay (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Holidays with Pay Ordinance, 1952, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —  
(a) by renumbering section nine as section ten and  
(b) by the insertion after section eight of the following new section —

9. (1) The Commissioner of Labour may institute or cause to be instituted any prosecution for the purpose of enforcing any of the provisions of this Ordinance or of any regulations or orders made thereunder.

(2) Any officer of the Department of Labour may, although he is not a barrister or a solicitor prosecute or conduct before any court having jurisdiction any information, complaint or other proceeding arising under this Ordinance or of any regulations or orders made thereunder."
