Provision as to pending actions and scope of Ordinance.

- 3. Nothing in this Ordinance shall---
- (a) affect any proceedings instituted before the commencement of this Ordinance; cr
- (b) empower a Court to order an employer to pay any sum in respect of wages which have become due more than one year prior to the commencement of this Ordinance
