BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 48 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Housing Ordinance with respect to the constitution of the Central Housing and Planning Authority.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Housing Ordinance, 1946, herein referred to as the Principal Ordinance, as amended from time to time.

2. Subsection (1) of section four of the Principal Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor —

“ (1) The Central Authority shall consist of —

- (a) a person who is a councillor or a person who is an officer of the Council, and is appointed by the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown;
- (b) a person who is a councillor or a person who is an officer of the Council and is appointed by the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam;
- and
- (c) nine other fit and proper persons to be appointed by the Governor."

Passed by the Legislative Council this seventeenth day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
