BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 49 OF 1955.

An Ordinance to amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1955. Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, hereinafter cap. 103. referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Part I of the first Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the fourth line thereof by the substitution of I of the the word "including" for the word "except" and by the deletion First Scheof the word "exclusively".
