BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 34 of 1955.

An Ordinance further to amend the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1949, to provide for the increasing of the borrowing powers of the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1949, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (1) of section one hundred and ninety-five of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "six hundred" appearing therein of the words "nine hundred and fifty", and by the substitution for the symbol, commas and figures "\$600,000," in the marginal note thereof of the symbol, commas and figures "\$950,000,".
