BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 35 OF 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Tax Ordinance, 1939.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment No. 3) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after section five of the following new section to be numbered 5 A —

“5 A. There shall be raised, levied and collected on all beer manufactured in the Colony, and taken or sold for consumption in the Colony, a duty at the rate of fifty cents for every liquid gallon and in proportion for any less quantity than a liquid gallon.”

Passed by the Legislative Council this ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
