## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 58 of 1955.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Audit Department Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Audit Department (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Audit Department Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance as amended by section two of the Audit Department (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1949, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) by the substitution for the words "four hundred and fifty pounds" of the words "five hundred pounds";
- (b) by the substitution for the words "Director of Colonial Audit" of the words "Director General of the Oversea Audit Service";
- (c) by the substitution for the word "Director" in the last line thereof of the words "Director General";
- (d) by the substitution for the words "colonial audit" in the marginal note thereof of the words "oversea audit service".
