AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Deceased Persons Estates' Administration Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deceased Persons Estates' Administration (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Deceased Persons Estates' Administration Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. and any Ordinance amending the same.

- (a) by the substitution of a semicolon for the comma after the word "attend" in the twelfth line; and
 - (b) by the deletion of the words "unless in the opinion of the registrar a sufficient inventory and valuation in terms of section 33 of this Ordinance have already been furnished;"

3. Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "unless in the opinion of the registrar a sufficient inventory and valuation in terms of section 33 of this Ordinance have already been furnished,".

4. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor may by Proclamation appoint.
