AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Tax Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (2) of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "the Registrar of Deeds is" of the words "the Commissioners of Inland Revenue are".

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor may by Proclamation appoint.
