1. Short Title
2. Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Public Health Ordinance with respect to the constitution of the Central Board of Health.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Public Health Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by the Statutory Authorities Ordinance, 1953, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor —

- “(2) The Board shall consist of —
- (a) the Director of Medical Services who shall be the Chairman of the Board;
 - (b) a person who is a councillor or a person who is an officer of the Council, and is appointed by the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown;
 - (c) a person who is a councillor or a person who is an officer of the Council, and is appointed by the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam; and
 - (d) not more than nine other fit and proper persons to be appointed by the Governor.”

Passed by the Legislative Council this tenth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
