Arrangement of Sections.

Section

1. Short title.
2. Repeal and re-enactment of section 25 of the Principal Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, to make provision for the pensions of officers whose service has been combined with service in certain health services or with service in the New Amsterdam Fire Brigade.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Repeal and re-enactment of section 25 of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 25 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor —

"Pensions of officers with service in certain Health Services, etc.

25. In computing for the purposes of this Ordinance the pension of any officer who has, in addition to his public service, served in —

- (a) the Society for the Prevention and Treatment of Tuberculosis;
- (b) the Infant Welfare and Maternity League;
- or
- (c) (before the 1st January, 1953) the New Amsterdam Fire Brigade,—

his service in the said Society or in the said League or (before the 1st January, 1953) in the said Brigade, as the case may be, shall be taken into account as if it had been service of the Colony."

Passed by the Legislative Council this seventeenth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
