AN ORDINANCE to amend the Deeds Registry Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Deeds Registry Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title.
