2. Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Auctioneers Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Auctioneers (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Auctioneers Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Chapter 150.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereafter of the following proviso —

“Provided that any person may, if authorised by the Local Government Board, sell at auction without a licence any lands under the provisions of Section 152 of the Local Government Ordinance.”

Passed by the Legislative Council this thirtieth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
