### ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS.

#### Section

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 203 of Chapter 152.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance with respect to the borrowing powers of the Council.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any ordinance amending the same.

2. Section 203 of the Principal Ordinance as amended by section 2 of the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance 1954, is hereby further amended by the substitution for the words "two hundred thousand" in subsections (1) and (2) thereof of the words "four hundred thousand".
