AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Mining Ordinance with respect to the payment of royalty on timber.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mining Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (2) of section 22 of the Principal Ordinance as repealed and re-enacted by section 2 of the Mining (Consolidation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby repealed, and the following subsection substituted therefor —

“(2) The holder of any concession or lease granted under this Ordinance shall not remove or allow to be removed from any such concession or lease any timber cut thereon except on the payment of royalty at the rates prescribed by the Crown Lands Regulations.”
