AN ORDINANCE to amend the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment
of Section 3
of Ordinance No. 28
of 1953.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a colon for the full stop at the end thereof, and adding the following —

“Provided that no salary provided for by this section shall be paid to a Member of the Legislative Council in respect of any period during which such Member has been suspended from the exercise of his functions as such or from the service of the Council in pursuance of any law or of any Standing Order for the regulation and conduct of the proceedings of the Legislative Council.”

Passed by the Legislative Council this second day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
