AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1959

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Customs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The table of Export Duties in Part I of the first schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as amended from time to time is hereby further amended—

- (a) by the renumbering of items 4 and 5 as items 5 and 6, respectively; and
- (b) by the insertion after item 3 of the following item —
“4. Unrefined cane sugar (as classified in items 061-01.1 to 061-01.4 of the Trade Classification List and Tariff hereinbefore contained . . . per ton \$1.00”.

3. Item 3 of Part IV of the first schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the words “excluding unrefined cane sugar”.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1959.
