AN ORDINANCE to amend the Fire Prevention Ordinance, 1954.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1959.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fire Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Fire Prevention Ordinance, 1954, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of the definition of the expression "inspector" and by the substitution therefor of the following definition —

““inspector” means any member of the British Gujana Fire Brigade authorised in writing by the Chief Fire Officer thereof to inspect premises under this Ordinance or any regulations made thereunder;”

3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “authorised in writing by the Superintendent”.
