AN ORDINANCE further to extend the duration of the New Amsterdam Electric Lighting Order, 1900.

[13th April, 1957]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Electric Lighting Order (Extension) Ordinance, 1957.

Short title.

2. In this Ordinance —

“the Order” means the New Amsterdam Electric Lighting Order, 1900;

Interpretation.

“the Principal Ordinance” means the Electric Lighting Ordinance.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (e) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance, the Order, as amended from time to time, and extended by the Electric Lighting Ordinance, 1932, and further extended by the New Amsterdam Electric Lighting Order (Extension) Ordinance, 1951, for the period commencing on the 23rd of August, 1950 and ending on the 31st of December, 1951, shall continue to have effect and shall be deemed always to have continued to have effect as though an extension of the Order as amended had been granted by the Governor in Council in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (e) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance for a period of six years commencing on the 1st of January, 1952.
