AN ORDINANCE to amend the Industries Aid and Encouragement Ordinance.

[13th July, 1957.]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1957.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industries Aid and Encouragement (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Industries Aid and Encouragement Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 109.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Ordinance, as substituted by section 2 of the Industries Aid and Encouragement (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, is hereby further amended by the addition of the following item thereto:

- “(7) Materials for the construction of houses for employees and for ancillary basic township services where the Governor in Council is satisfied that such facilities do not exist and where such facilities are provided by the industry itself.”
