AN ORDINANCE to make special provision in regard to the pension and gratuity payable to Pauline Gomes d'Abreu.

[13th July, 1957.]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1957.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the d'Abreu Pension Ordinance, 1957.

Short title.

2. Anything in section 3 of the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, to the contrary notwithstanding, the pension granted to Pauline Gomes d'Abreu shall be, and is hereby declared to be at the rate of five hundred and twenty-five dollars and twenty-five cents *per annum* and the gratuity payable to the said Pauline Gomes d'Abreu shall be, and is hereby declared to be, two thousand one hundred and eighty-eight dollars and fifty cents.

Grant of special pension and gratuity to Pauline Gomes d'Abreu. Cap. 73.

3. Save as in this Ordinance provided the provisions of the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, shall apply to the pension granted to Pauline Gomes d'Abreu as though the said pension were granted under that Ordinance.

Pension to be subject to the provisions of the Pensions Ordinance, 1933.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st July, 1956.
