AN ORDINANCE to make special provision in regard to the pension and gratuity payable to Vivian Charles Dias.

[13th July, 1957.]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dias Pension Ordinance, 1957.

2. Anything in section 3 of the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, to the contrary notwithstanding, the pension granted to Vivian Charles Dias shall be, and is hereby declared to be, at the rate of one thousand eight hundred and forty-six dollars and twenty cents *per annum*, and the gratuity payable to the said Vivian Charles Dias shall be, and is hereby declared to be seven thousand six hundred and ninety-two dollars and fifty cents.

3. Save as in this Ordinance provided, the provisions of the Pensions Ordinance, 1933, shall apply to the pension granted to Vivian Charles Dias as though the said pension were granted under the aforesaid Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 1st November, 1957.
