Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post and Telegraph (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957 and shall be construed and read as one with the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment

2. Subsection (1) of section 29 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso —

“Provided further that nothing in this subsection shall apply to the posting or transmission of radio-active substances in accordance with the regulations; and the receipt, acceptance, transmission or delivery of radio-active substances by the postal department shall be deemed a special service for the purpose of subsection (1) (m) of section 97 of this Ordinance.”
