AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance.

(20th July, 1957).

A.D. 1957. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Cap. 152.

2. Section 138 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
 - (a) by the insertion after the words “the Ursuline convent and the land therewith occupied;” of the words “the convent of the Good Shepherd and the land therewith occupied;” and
 - (b) by the insertion after the words “British Guiana Nurses Association,” of the words “of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals”.
