AN ORDINANCE to amend the Town and Country Planning Ordinance.

[12th October, 1957]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed, and read as one with the Town and Country Planning Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Cap. 181.

2. Subsection (6) of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor—

Amendment of section 8 of Chapter 181.

“(6) A scheme when approved by the Governor in Council under this section shall have full force and effect as from the date of the publication of the notice of approval aforesaid.”

Validation.

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Ordinance no building operation carried out in pursuance of any application for building purposes granted by the Mayor and Town Council of the City of Georgetown between the 29th August, 1957, and the coming into operation of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have been unlawfully carried out on the ground that it was in contravention of, or failed to comply with the requirements of, any scheme approved by the Governor in Council under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance.

Date of commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 27th October, 1951,
