AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Health Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read with the Public Health Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

3. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

Amendment of section 16 of Principal Ordinance.

(a) by the deletion of the words "or a Health Officer," in subsection (1); and

(b) by the deletion of the words "Health Officer," in subsection (2).
