AN ORDINANCE to make special provision with respect to the pension of Desmond John Parkinson.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Parkinson Pension Ordinance, 1958. Short title.

2. In this Ordinance—

“the Principal Ordinance” means the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, and any Ordinance amending the same.

3. Anything in the provisions of the Principal Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the service of Desmond John Parkinson between the period commencing on the 3rd October, 1952, and ending on the 5th October, 1955, both dates inclusive, shall, for the purposes of the Principal Ordinance, be deemed to be pensionable service.
