AN ORDINANCE to amend the Rent Restriction Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rent Restriction (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read as one with the Rent Restriction Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (4) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, without prejudice, however, to anything done in pursuance of the said subsection prior to the enactment of this Ordinance :

Provided that where an agreement in respect of a tenancy for a period of five years or upwards has been made before the enactment of this Ordinance and the agreement includes a provision requiring the payment of any fine, premium, or other like sum, or the giving of any consideration in addition to the rent which could lawfully have been required prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, such provision shall cease to have effect.
