AN ORDINANCE to amend the Tax Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read with the Tax Ordinance,

hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Repeal and re-enactment of section 22 of Chapter 298.

2. (1) Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor--

"Applicant for licence to produce certificate of registration.

No. 36 of 1956.

22. No licence referred to in section 20 or section 21 of this Ordinance shall be issued unless there is produced at the time of application therefor a certificate signed by the Registrar of the Pharmacy and Poisons Board stating that the premises in respect of which the licence is sought are registered under section 23 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, 1956."

(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section shall affect the validity of any licence issued under section 22 of the Principal Ordinance prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.
